50 Lives 50 Homes

Ruah is the lead agency of the 50 Lives 50 Homes campaign, working with organisations across multiple sectors to collaboratively address challenges of housing Perth’s most vulnerable rough sleeping homeless population.

Using a Housing First approach, 50 Lives 50 Homes works towards ending homelessness, finding housing for the most vulnerable rough sleepers and then providing wrap around support to reduce the risk of returning to homelessness.

Within the first 18 months of the campaign more than 50 clients were successfully housed with many others being supported. Clients of the campaign have access to after hours support thanks to the After Hours Support Service.

To ensure you receive the best support that works for you, our services are personalised and flexible. We walk alongside you to achieve your goals and improve your quality of life.

Our commitment to end homelessness has led to the development of innovative campaigns and programs. We believe in a 'Housing First' approach to end homelessness. Our services are designed to get people into a safe and secure environment and then provide services to support their tenancy and wellbeing.

This means that people are less likely to return to homelessness after being housed, and we can prevent people becoming homeless.

Our services include:

The Ruah Centre

The Ruah Centre is a planned response service where we work one on one with people who want to make changes in their lives. This includes supporting people with:

- Getting an ID
- Applying for housing
- Accessing alcohol and other drug services
- Accessing mental health services
- Information, advocacy and referrals

Clients can also access co-located services such as counselling, the Mental Health Law Centre, Centrelink, NDIS and mental health case management.

The Ruah Centre is located at 33 Shenton Street, Northbridge. It's opening hours are Monday to Friday 8.30am to 3.30pm, closed on Public Holidays.

Crisis support and basic services including immediate healthcare, showers, food and internet access are available every day from 7am to 7pm at Tranby Centre, located at 5 Aberdeen Street.

Mobile Outreach Team

Supports people to access stable and long-term housing and achieve positive outcomes. The team can support people who have had long periods of rough sleeping, have had a recent mental health inpatient admission and people who are exiting or have been recently released from women's prisons.

South-East Tenancy

Assists people to maintain private rental tenancies. This program is for individuals and families in the south-east metropolitan corridor of Perth.

After Hours Support Service

Provides wrap around support to 50 Lives 50 Homes clients, this team ensures clients have access to critical support services after business hours.
